



MOSES LAKE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOUND PROPERTY FORM

CASE _____

Any person who finds property that is lawful to possess, and the owner of which is unknown, and who wishes to claim the found property will obey state law noted in RCW 63.21 as follows:

- Within seven (7) days surrender the found property to the Moses Lake Police Department, in the jurisdiction where the property was found.
- Serve written notice upon the Evidence Officer of the Moses Lake Police Department of their intent to claim the property if the owner does not make claim.
- After sixty (60) days have passed, or after the final disposition of any judicial or other official proceeding involving the property, show evidence of their original intent to claim the property and it shall be released and become the property of the finder.
- After ninety (90) days have passed, or after the final disposition of any judicial or other official proceeding involving the property, and the finder has not completed the requirements of this chapter, the finder's claim shall be deemed to have expired and the found property may be disposed of as unclaimed property.

The finder's claim to the property shall be extinguished if the owner is found within sixty (60) days after the find was reported, or if the officer determines the property is illegal to possess.
